INSTRUCTIONS AFTER BREAST CYST ASPIRATION OR NEEDLE BIOPSY

1. PAIN CONTROL

- You may have mild discomfort or soreness.
- Take 1 or 2 Tylenol (acetaminophen) every 4- 6 hours, per the instructions on the bottle.

DO NOT TAKE ASPIRIN, IBUPROFEN (Advil), OR NAPROXEN (Aleve) x 2 days

2. WOUND CARE

- A small amount of bleeding or bruising is possible at the procedure site.
- The bandage over the site may be removed before bedtime tonight or tomorrow.
- Keep the site clean and dry. You may shower after 24 hours.

3. ACTIVITY

- You may resume work without restriction after 24 hours.

4. FOLLOW-UP

- Should you have excessive bleeding, further discoloration of your skin around the site, excessive swelling, or fever contact the center or your physician
- If specimens were taken today, they will be sent to the lab to be analyzed by a Pathologist. It will take approximately 3-4 business days for these results to be available. The results will be sent to <u>your physician who will contact you</u>. We will not be able to give you the results at the imaging center.
